CVC Activities

- 1. Play <u>KaBoom!</u> or <u>Fiddlesticks</u>. Select words representing each vowel sound or pattern.
- 2. <u>Mad Minute</u>: Challenge your child to see how many he/she can read in one minute. Record the score.
- 3. Play <u>Memory</u> game. Write words on flashcards and play Memory
- 4. Play <u>Hopscotch</u> and write the words instead of numbers.
- 5. Make up a **board game** using the words and a die. [Share at school]
- 6. Write abc letters on cards. Make two sets. Place 3 letters on the table. The middle letter must be a vowel. Challenge your child to read the word.

Change ONE of the letters. Not the vowel. Challenge your child to read the word. The student can sound out the letters, but he/she must say the word properly to score a point. [optional: reward with a small treat]

Repeat, changing one letter at a time. You may change the vowel with another vowel.

You can make up nonsense words.

- 7. **Word Sort**. Write some of the words on flashcards and have your child sort them by ending rime, then read the lists.
- 8. Make a <u>FLIP BOOK</u> (see attached)
